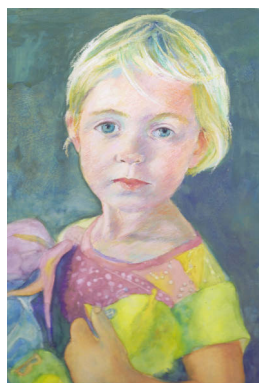
Gen Y Networking Group is a forum dedicated to job searching, networking, and career development. The group is open to all job seekers.

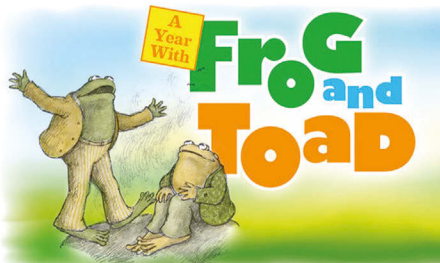

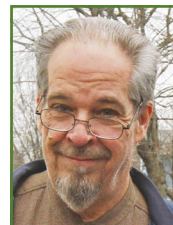
