## ***Bridging Space to Place — Project Approved***

The Library Board of Trustees has approved a revamped building plan and Investors Foundation generously granted funds.

Investors Bank Assistant Vice President and Chatham Branch Manager Mark Cody presented \$50,000 of a \$150,000 grant awarded to the Library of the Chathams *Bridging Space to Place* project. For years, progress was on hold while the library waited for a state-run library construction grant application to become available. Like the majority of libraries that applied, we did not win funding and were further stalled by the pandemic and recovery. We are now ready to move forward!

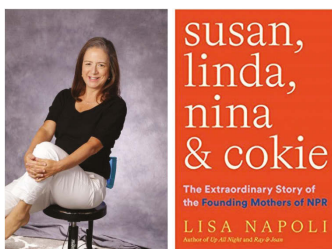

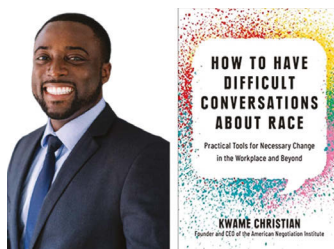

Acclaimed writer and journalist

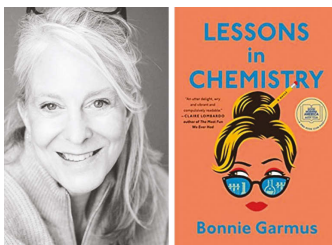
Lisa Napoli will discuss her group biography of the four women whose voices defined NPR.

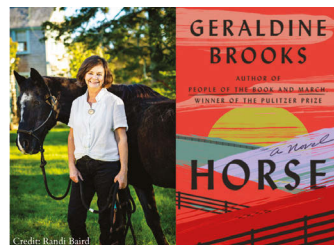
Negotiation expert Kwame Christian will discuss how to gain the confidence to talk about race, and actually make a difference when you do.

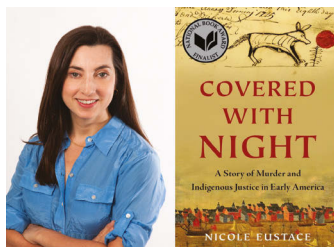
A virtual chat with author Bonnie Garmus about her debut novel which features the singular voice of chemist Elizabeth Zott in the 1960s.

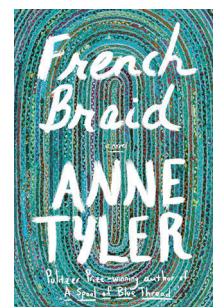

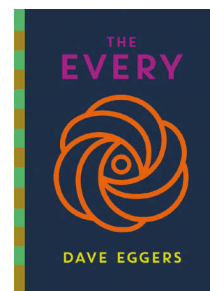

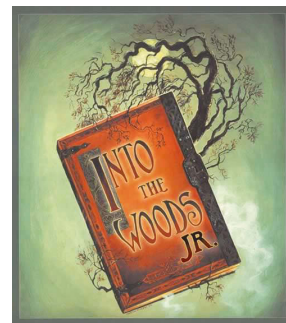

Fundamental improvements of this \$5 million venture will include components designed to respond to the variety of needs and expectations of our residents. Each component ensures that what we invest today will benefit all who enter our doors for decades to come.

The *Bridging Space to Place* project includes:

- A Teen Center and Teen Work Rooms
- A multipurpose STEM Room
- A new Children's Center and Activity Room
- Four new Quiet Study Rooms
- A dedicated Business Center
- Flexible meeting spaces
- Expanded programming space
- An upgraded Local History Room and Archival Preservation Room
- Improved back entrance with a more user-friendly access ramp.
